PROCESS OVERVIEW

There are three stages in the Via Fidei process:

- Discovery Phase:
 - Uncovering the needs and opportunities important to the parish and the community
- Solution Phase:
 - Determining how best to address those needs and opportunities
- Implementation Phase:
 - Implementing the approved solutions

Each phase of the process has a number of components, each of which enables us to deepen our understanding, create innovative approaches and efficiently install the selected ideas.

For example, during the Discovery Phase at OLP, we:

- Held two focus group sessions
- Published a parish-wide survey
- Met with the Parish Council and parish staff
- Organized, analyzed and calculated all the data received from all sources and developed ten Focus Areas

KEY FOCUS AREAS

Based on the study of the data and using an analysis technique called 'verbal averaging', the following objectives are being considered:

- Becoming a community leader, known for how we live out our Faith, inside and outside the parish
- Making and growing disciples
- Expanding programs and services to Seniors
- Making OLP a more important part of every parishioner's life
- Getting us all, to know us all, better
- Making Faith Formation (at all levels) engaging and attractive
- Supporting our families
- Opening ourselves to all who need us, regardless...
- Providing powerful faith-based experiences: Ministries, Liturgies, etc.
- Communicating more effectively with all parishioners

NEXT STEPS: As we move to close the Discovery Phase and head into the Solution Phase, we are going to have lots of opportunities to participate. Here are two important next steps...

Via Fidei Parish Ministry

The whole point of this process is to assist each parish as they take control of their future. In order to transition the process to the parish, we need to create a Via Fidei ministry here at Pompeii. Essentially, this ministry will coordinate and support the initiative and assist the Working Teams as they begin the effort of creating and implementing solutions that will address the Key Focus Areas. This is an opportunity for parishioners looking to find ways to make a significant contribution to the parish.
